

Qualifications

1. The qualification period is composed of:
 - A. The current year up to the final close of entries.
 - B. The previous 14 months (i.e for 2025 shows the previous year (2024) PLUS November and December of 2023)
2. There are 3 Levels of Shows.
 - A. Level 1 - AHA Recognized Qualifying Shows which includes Concurrent Shows, Pre-Shows, Value Shows & Lite Shows. i.e. Buckeye, Scottsdale
 - Participation Qualifies for Regionals and Nationals
 - B. Level 2 - Regional and Regional Off-Site Championships, East Coast, Pacific Slope, Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders.
 - Top 5/6 qualify for Nationals (Level 3).
 - C. Level 3 - National Championships.
3. You can compete in any region regardless of what region you qualified in.
 - A. Example - The qualification could have been earned in Region 8 but was used for the Region 6 Championship Show.
4. An Amateur must qualify the horse to participate in an Amateur or Amateur Owner class. **i.e., Any Amateur can qualify a horse for an owner class; however, only an owner can ride in an Owner class per USEF rules.**
5. A professional can use amateur-earned participation.
6. A Walk/Trot Rider 10 & Under must qualify the horse to participate in Walk/Trot 10 & Under Classes. A Walk/Trot Rider 11 & Over must qualify the horse to participate in Walk/Trot 11 & Over Classes.
7. Participate in a class in a recognized section, i.e., HA/AA Western Pleasure, Arabian Country English Pleasure, Arabian Hunter Pleasure, etc. Compete in any recognized class within that section.
For Dressage, each level is considered its own section.
***Exception:** Performance Halter / VRH Ranch Horse Conformation classes do NOT require competing in the Performance Halter Section or VRH Ranch Horse Conformation Section. The horse must be qualified, entered and adjudicated in a performance or VRH Ranch class at that show. This is the only qualification required, including Regional and National Shows.*
8. For classes in Category I to Compete at **more** than one (1) Regional / Level 2 Show you must;
 - Participate at two Level 1 AHA Recognized Qualifying Shows and compete at any and as many Regional Championships in that section.
9. For classes in Category II & V to Compete at one (1) Regional / Level 2 Show you must;
 - Participate in that one recognized class in that section now qualifies you to compete in as many classes within that section at any one Regional Championship Show of your choice in that section.
Example: Participate at a Level 1 qualifying show in HA/AA Western Pleasure ATR qualifies for any and as many classes in HA/AA Western Pleasure as long as you meet the definition for an Amateur, Amateur Owner, Leveling, Jr. Horse, etc.
10. Equitation is based on the rider and the rider must participate in their qualifying section.
 - A. Youth – to qualify for a National Championship Show, a rider must:
 1. Win a Medal, in an **AHA Medal class** with three or more entries **OR**
 2. Obtain the required participation qualification from Medal classes **OR**
 3. Obtain a Top Five / Six or better from the corresponding Regional (Level 2) Equitation Championship class.
 - B. Adult – to qualify for a National Championship Show, a rider must obtain:
 1. The required participation qualification **OR**
 2. Obtain a Top Five / Six or better from corresponding classes in Regional (Level 2) Championship Shows. (For classes requiring a pattern, see USEF Subchapter AR 29).
11. Participation can also be used to qualify in Specialty classes and can be obtained through Open Shows (and placings for Working Western/Dressage/Western Dressage). Must be enrolled in the Open Qualifying Program. Refer to the AHA Handbook, Chapter 15, Open Qualifying Competitions.
12. A National Show Commission has the right to place restrictions on cross entry into classes.

13. The USEF/EC family definition and two distinct non-family owner definitions must be adhered to.

For competition purposes, the term family includes spouse, parent, step-parent, child, brother, stepchild, sister, half-brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather, grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above. (GR 123)

To show in Amateur Owner classes, two distinct non-family co-owners must adhere to the following: (see AR 110.4.e for complete rules)

- A. Must be registered as an "AND" ownership and limited to 2 individuals. No Farm or Corporation co-owned horses are eligible.
- B. No family member of a professional may enter into this relationship,
- C. No family member of a distinct non family owner may receive any remuneration in relation to the co-owned horse as defined in SUBCHAPTER 13-B AMATEURS AND PROFESSIONALS (or Equestrian Canada equivalent).
- D. Does not extend to the family of these distinct non family owners,
- E. Not eligible for ABS Jackpot Classes or Maturity Classes at Nationals,
- F. Associations or Clubs may elect to not allow horses to compete in Owner classes where prize money payouts are greater than \$2500.00.

14. Obtain a Regional placing (Level 2) and compete at **any** and as **many** National Championships in that section. If you do not get a Regional placing, ONE (1) participation from Regionals (Level 2) can be used **FOR NATIONAL ONLY**. See #4 for Amateur and Owner classes.

- **EXCEPTION: Placing in Restricted Regional Arabian and HA/AA ABS Yearling classes can NOT be used for USN HA/AA Yearling classes OR the Yearling Geldings AAOTH class at USN.**

15. Participation definition:

- A. In a class where horses compete together, participated means a horse/rider/driver/handler must have been entered, shown, and judged (must attempt to perform at all required gaits both ways of the ring and remain in the ring until excused by the judge). In other words, finishing the class.
- B. In a class where horses compete individually, participation means a horse/rider must have completed the individual requirements of the class and be eligible to receive a score.
- C. Horses that are excused/disqualified/eliminated/received a "no score" are not considered "adjudicated".

National Qualifications from National Shows. See QUAL 113 for complete rules.

Qualifications must come from "that" Nationals Class BUT can be used at any National. The age of the Amateur or Owner does not effect qualifications.

"That" is defined as;

Open for Open,

Junior Horse for Junior Horse (must still be a Junior horse per USEF rules).

Amateur for Amateur (AT/AAT/JT).

Owner for Owner (AO/AAO/JO).

i.e. A National Champion in JO can be used to qualify for AAO/AAO but for NOT for AT/AAT/JT.

National Champions from 2019 and before are qualified for life.

National Champions from 2020 and on are qualified for an additional 2 years.

Reserve National Champions from 2020 and on are qualified for an additional 1 year.

National Champion or Reserve National Champion in Sport Horse (not split by type) may use that qualification for either Dressage Type or Hunter Type BUT not both.

US National Arabian Open Sr Champion Stallion or US National Arabian Open Sr Mare are no longer eligible to participate at US Nationals in their respective class after achieving said Title.

Participate at one (1) AHA Qualifying Level 1 Show or “Open Qualifying Show” to compete at any and as many Regional Championships Qualifying Shows”

National Qualifications:

Regional Top 5/6 (Level 2) or better **OR**

Participate at two (2) AHA Approved Shows, Level 1 **OR** “Open Qualifying Show”

FEI Levels:

Participate at one (1) AHA Approved Level 1 show **OR “Open Qualifying Show”**

AHA CLASS QUALIFICATION CHART

1. A Top 5 /6 or better at Regionals (Level 2 Show) is an automatic qualification for Nationals.

East Coast, Pacific Slope, Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders are considered as Regionals (Level 2 Show)

2. For Category 1 - Participate at two (2) Level 1 AHA Recognized Qualifying Shows and compete at any and as many Regional Championships in that section.

3. For Categories II & V Participate in one (1) Level 1 AHA Recognized Qualifying Shows and compete at any and as many Regional Championships in that section.

4. Any amateur can qualify a horse for an owner class however only an owner can ride in an Owner Class per USEF rules.

A pro can use participations earned by an amateur, but an amateur can not use participations earned by a pro.

DNA = DNA is required for Half-Arabians
