

Qualification Flow Chart for Regional and National Equitation

Nationals

AHA JTR MEDAL CLASSES

Are only offered at Local shows

Patterns are required in all Medal Classes

Medal classes qualify for Nationals 3 ways:

1. Medal = 1st place earned in a Medal Class with 3 or more riders.
2. Participation from 3 Medal Classes
3. Participation from 2 Medal Classes and 1 Regional Equitation class

REGIONAL EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Top 5 = Is an Automatic Qualification For National Classes

May use one Regional participation for Nationals

Patterns are required in all Regional Equitation classes with the exception of Walk/Trot Equitation

UPHA CHALLENGE CUP

Can qualify for Nationals 2 ways:

1. **All Breeds Challenge Cup** but must ride an Arabian or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian, with a 1st - 4th place **Qualification MUST BE VERIFIED BY UPHA**

2. **Arabian Breeds Challenge Cup** (held at an Arabian Show) with a 1st - 4th place

For Qualifications, see the UPHA rules in the USEF Equitation Chapter

The qualification period is 7 days from the first day of last year's show to 7 days prior to the first day of the current year's show

JTR/ATR/AATR LOCAL SHOW EQUITATION & MEDAL CLASSES

Can qualify for Regionals By Participation. See Category I for Regionals.

Refer to rule below for Local JTR Equitation Rules

MEDAL CLASSES MAY ONLY HELD AT LOCAL SHOWS

If a show offers a Junior Exhibitor Division it **must** offer Lead in and Medal classes. The Lead in Equitation classes AND Medal classes can be TBA classes. Expectation: Value Shows

Saddle Seat Equitation JTR
Western Horsemanship JTR
Western or Reining Seat Equitation JTR
Hunt Seat Equitation Not To Jump JTR
Hunt Seat Equitation Over Fences JTR
* *Dressage Seat Equitation JTR*

AHA Saddle Seat **Medal** JTR
AHA Western Horsemanship **Medal** JTR
AHA Reining Seat **Medal** JTR
AHA Hunt Seat **Medal** Not To Jump JTR
AHA Hunt Seat **Medal** Over Fences JTR
* *AHA Dressage Seat **Medal** JTR*
* *Required Only if Dressage is offered*

NO Qualifications for Regionals or Nationals are required for Adult Dressage Seat Equitation and Adult Hunter Seat Equitation Over Fences
