Historically an AHA Value Show has 40 to 45 horses in attendance. This format was designed to keep these smaller shows relevant for areas with lower horse populations. We encourage fees and expenses to remain low so that the cost savings can be passed along to the exhibitor. We realize that this may not always be the case, but we encourage the use of facilities that may be on the lower end (without compromising the footing).

Suggested that ribbons be awarded thru 6th place (remember that all horses that complete the class are to be reported for participation qualifications). There will be no paybacks in classes except for those which may be designated as Jackpot classes.

Classes will be run and adjudicated based on the current USEF Rulebook. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason including but not limited to: unsportsmanlike conduct and animal cruelty.

Copies of Registration papers and current AHA competition membership cards for owners, trainers and riders must be presented at time of entries.
