Sport Horse In-Hand Championships and Reserve Championships will have the number in the class determined by two (2) horses in each lead-in class to that Championship. (See the example to the left.) No horse may be named Champions and Reserve. If the same horse has the two (2) highest scores, the next highest eligible horse will be named Reserve Champion.  
*In case of tie: Movement is first; Conformation, second; Overall Balance & Harmony, third; Expression & Manners, fourth. If horses are still tied, judge must decide.*

The number in the Championship would be five (5).
